SYNOPSIS

After her near-death car accident that leaves her with mangled arms and severe bone damage, doctors are ready to amputate. Lucky for Averie, the CIA has been working on a state-of-the-art Bionic Arm Transplant that can change the course of international espionage. These Bionic Arms, fully concealed under her skin, ensure kill-shots from 4000 yards away with deadly accuracy. But the arm transplants come with a price. She now must work for the CIA as an Assassin, to make her country safer.

DIRECTOR'S STATEMENT

I was ten years old the first time I saw a female hero with bionic arms on screen. I thought that was the coolest thing ever. There was something special about someone being rebuilt — stronger, faster, capable of things no ordinary human could do — who still had to choose, every day, how to stay human inside. That struggle became the seed of Mission – Averie nearly 45 years later.

I wanted to make a film about a woman who is given a second chance at life, but with restrictions she can't control. That's her new reality, and she must live with it every day of her life.

Shooting on 35mm film was an absolute gift. That allowed for beautiful, gorgeous and absolutely stunning cinematic images. It was a choice about texture and truth. Film has warmth and imperfections, a kind of physical honesty. For a story about what stays human underneath the machine, film was a clear choice. It was a magical choice, and I'm excited for the audience to see its rich color palettes.

I wanted to make a movie that would take the audience on a journey of all senses, a total audio-visual experience. I wanted the audience to be immersed in a musical journey, which is why I edited the movie WITH MUSIC, as opposed to editing the movie and adding music after the fact. This way, the music, or the length of a piece of music, would dictate my editing decisions.

This film also carries a piece of my own story. I left my hometown 28 years ago to move to Los Angeles, with no guarantee it would work out. I understand what it means to rebuild a life from nothing and hope the person underneath survives the process. Averie's journey isn't mine — but the questions she's asking are ones I've asked myself many, many, many times over. I rebuilt myself from scratch at least three times in my life!!!

Mission – Averie is, at its core, a love story. Everything else — the CIA, the bionics, the action — exists to test how far that love can be pushed before it breaks. My hope is that audiences leave thinking less about the technology, and more about the heart. It's a feel-good movie. I made it to uplift your spirit, push you to be yourself and to follow your dreams.
